King David has the best of intentions but his timing is off. David wants to build a house for the Presence of God and God seemingly prefers a tent. God has operated in a movable Tabernacle displaying his power and might among the nations for years and David is looking to build an immovable "museum" of sorts.

- 1. You are a faithful priest. You are called to be a priest among the people of your community.
- 2. Be on the move today. Move in and out of people's lives and interact with them as though you are bringing the shining light of Jesus Christ with you because you are.
- 3. God appreciates stillness but eventually he gets bored with it. He died for the people in your life. The odds of them running over to the church today on their lunch hour is quite slim. Perhaps you are the closest they will get to Christ.
- 4. Be on the move today. You are an ambassador—be diplomatic among the people in your life and be fully alive as you do so.
- 5. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God (2 Cor. 5:20-21).
- 6. You are a faithful priest—act like it. Act not just faithful and not just as a priest—act as a faithful priest and enjoy all that the Lord has for you.
